

<u>Walking Group</u> — *Lead: Member-Led (Angela)* — In-Person — Members go out for a light, relaxing stroll around Port Coquitlam.

<u>Wellness Wednesdays</u> — *Lead: Natasha* — In-Person — Group discussion, practice, or activity related to one's wellness takes place each week.
